## ProWein 2021

### FAQs

**Q: Why isn't Wine Australia participating in ProWein 2021?**

The ongoing travel restrictions and quarantine requirements due to the COVID-19 pandemic mean that our exhibitors are not able to travel to Europe. We have therefore decided not to participate in ProWein 2021.

**Q: Will Wine Australia attend ProWein in the future?**

Yes, it is our intention to carry over our ProWein 2021 stand space and exhibitors to ProWein 2022. We will liaise with our exhibitors in due course to check whether they are still interested in participating and in what capacity.

**Q: Have exhibitors already paid to be on Wine Australia's ProWein 2021 stand and, if so, when will they be refunded?**

Exhibitors on Wine Australia's ProWein 2021 stand have not yet paid for the space, therefore refunds do not need to be arranged.

**Q: What if an exhibitor has already booked a flight to Europe or a hotel in Europe?**

Exhibitors will need to speak to their travel agent, airline or hotel if they have already made a booking.

**Q: Do exhibitors on Wine Australia's ProWein 2021 stand automatically have a space on the stand in 2022?**

We are planning to carry over our ProWein 2021 stand space and exhibitors to ProWein 2022. Those exhibitors who had committed to 2021 will be given first refusal for space for 2022.

**Q: How can exhibitors with European teams participate in ProWein 2021?**
